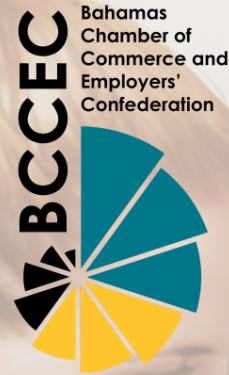


Our History

For over 200 years, the Bahamas Chamber of Commerce has promoted the commercial interests of the private business sector in the Bahamas. In 2011, the Bahamas Chamber of Commerce and The Bahamas Employers' Confederation amalgamated to form The Bahamas Chamber of Commerce and Employers' Confederation (BCCEC). Today the BCCEC is a Non-Government, Not-for-Profit, Business Member Organization that represents the interest of the private business sector and employers in The Bahamas. The amalgamation of the two entities has enabled the BCCEC to more effectively advocate for national policies that drive the socioeconomic climate of The Bahamas while encouraging the development of the business environment in the country.

The BCCEC works to stimulate and sustain the country's economic growth by providing a platform where members can engage in constructive dialog with the policymakers and the community activist to build a strong, sustainable, healthy, and robust economy. Though the islands that form our archipelago are unique, they encounter both common and island-specific challenges. For that reason, the BCCEC network of chambers consists of seven (7) Chambers of Commerce across The Bahamas. Through its working committees and the island-based Chambers of Commerce, BCCEC addresses matters that are of national importance and island-specific issues.

International partnerships are critical to the advancement of the BCCEC's mission. Hence, the BCCEC serves as the International Labour Organization's official representative in The Bahamas and maintains membership in the prestigious International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) and World Chambers Federation (WCF). Additionally, the BCCEC is a member of The International Organization of Employers (IOE), The Caribbean Employers Confederation (CEC), The Caribbean Association of Industry and Commerce (CAIC), and The Associations of Chambers of Commerce Executives (ACCE). Our membership in those organizations allows BCCEC to constantly explore approaches to improving its representation.
